SB 424 "Transactional Gold and Silver Act"

The Office of State Treasurer, so as to provide for gold and silver specie as legal tender; to provide for a bullion depository; to provide for an electronic payment system; to provide for guidelines, rules and regulations; to provide for insured deposits; to prohibit social credit scoring systems; to provide for annual reports; to prohibit taxation of transactions involving gold and silver specie and legal tender

Establishing mechanisms for the use of gold and silver as legal tender in transactions

The bullion depository shall utilize the electronic payment system to provide services for deposits of gold and silver bullion.

The commission, may: Operate a bullion depository directly ...The electronic payment system....Electronic payment systems and any participating vendors

Government take over of gold and silver and digital payment systems



HB 211 PFAS Receiver Shield Act so as to provide for immunity from certain lawsuits related to certain chemicals.. 'PFAS manufacturer'...No PFAS receiver shall be held liable for damages in an action involving a liability claim



SB 74 Harmful Materials to Minors; exemption for libraries and librarians from the provisions of Code.....repeal an exemption for libraries and librarians... selling, loaning, distributing, or exhibiting materials harmful to minors...Code Section 16-12-103 shall not apply to any public library operated by the state or any of its political subdivisions nor to any library operated as a part of any school, college, or university.



SB 214 Elections and Primaries; electors to cast physical absentee on-request ballots as an alternative to using other authorized means of casting in-person votes....so as to provide for new

voting equipment by the state 3 using and optical scanning voting system and hand marked paper ballots; to provide for 4 ballot on demand printing; to revise and provide for definitions



SB 9 "Ensuring Accountability for Illegal AI Activities Act".... relating to obscene material, distribution, and penalty; to amend Article 1 of Chapter 10 of Title 17...defendants who utilize artificial intelligence in the commission of certain crimes
