Georgia Senate Bill 129

"Georgia Supporting Those Who Sacrificed for Service Act"

PASSED SENATE 56-0 | STALLED IN THE HOUSE | ACT NOW

WHAT THIS BILL DOES FOR YOU:

- > **100% Disabled Veterans:** FULL property tax exemption on your home
- > **Partially Disabled Veterans:** Exemption proportional to your disability rating
- > **Example -- 70% Rating:** 70% of your home's assessed value is tax-exempt
- > **Applies to:** ALL property taxes -- state, county, city, and school

CURRENT STATUS:

PASSED: Georgia Senate unanimously (56-0) on March 6, 2025

PENDING: Sitting in House Ways & Means Committee -- no hearing scheduled

DEADLINE: Must pass the House THIS SESSION or the bill dies
